If you stuck for ideas, don't worry, our partners have provided some suggestions below.

North Wales Police

Ideas you could use...

- Create posters / leaflets to raise awareness of the appropriate speed to drive in your local community.
- Create a campaign to encourage children to wear cycle helmets and high viz gear.
- Launch a project to highlight Anti-Social Behaviour in your area.
- Think about environmental issues in your area, do a survey for your neighbours asking them what they feel most concerned about – What can you do to change things?
- Design a project which helps vulnerable people in your area reduce their risk of becoming victims of crime.
- Think of a project which raises awareness of online scams.

Raising awareness of:

- Organise a campaign to raise awareness about personal safety for young people – like how to stay safe when out alone or with friends
- Design a campaign to help people protect themselves against online scams and identity fraud.
- Raise awareness about the dangers of leaving valuables on display – such as in cars or gardens – and suggest simple security solutions.
- Create a project to promote cycle safety – run a workshop on safe cycling routes and gear.
- Promote safe spaces by organising a “Safer Streets” walkabout – identify poorly lit or vulnerable areas in your community and suggest improvements
